The scholarship Scheme is a goodwill gesture by the owners, is funded by them personally, and not a legal right, or a condition of your contract with PWAcademy.

Scholarship students (dependent on age) will be required to perform support activities as needed, including desk hours, special events and classroom assistance. Hours can vary. You will be expected to conduct yourself in a positive, professional, responsible, and courteous manner at all times.

#### **CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT**

1. All recipients must be an enrolled student in the Peploe-Williams Academy. Scholarship will be terminated if a Parent withdraws from the Academy for any reason. If the student leaves before their 18th Birthday, the normal fees will be applied to that last term.
2. If your child is accepted onto the PWA scholarship scheme and then subsequently drops classes that the Principal, EPW, considers key performing arts training for your child's development in the arts, we will withdraw the full scholarship. If a student is considering dropping classes at age 15 and over, they must attend an interview with EPW, if they are dropped after interview, the scholarship will be reduced by a %.
3. Students will attend all scheduled classes as recommended by the Academy, whether they are online or in the physical studio.
4. Students will participate in all PWA performances during the school years curriculum.
5. Policies - Our terms and conditions are there for good reason. Please follow them. Parents/students will abide by all the PWA terms and conditions in the Parent Contract, Parent Handbook, all policies, and the Parent/student charter.
6. Parents are expected to use the scholarship money to put back into their child's training with the Academy. If the scholarship is not used for this reason, the student will lose the scholarship.
7. The Scholarship fees may only be applied toward PWA courses, or outside courses that satisfy a technical requirement for certification in the student's performing arts career, and have Emma Peploe-Williams agreement. The student is not to study at any other theatre school, audition, or participate in any other non-related PWA performance without prior permission.
8. Absences are not allowed. Exceptions would be for severe injury, sickness, or family emergencies. Withdrawing from or failing to complete our curriculum with a grade of C or better will result in termination of scholarship opportunity.
9. Scholarship students must maintain a strong work ethic, and attend, and pass all dance, acting and singing examinations set by the Academy. Failure to maintain this standard will result in termination of the scholarship.
10. Parent/Legal guardian agrees that PWA may contact student for purposes of promoting its scholarship awards, and agrees, if contacted, to voluntarily provide, and let PWA use photographs, video footage, quotations, or any other information to help PWA in its public relations and fundraising efforts.
11. Scholarship will be reviewed each term in which student remains in PWA.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

Fundamentally, scholarships are given to parents (or those funding each student) based on the number of modules taken, longevity of membership, good payment record, relationship with Owners, workshops and summer schools taken by each child or teenager within the year. However, not all parents are able to work with us in this way, so we maintain competitive rates, even when scholarships may not be possible, without compromising the quality of education and learning, Scholarships on classes can vary from 5% - 30%.

Each Scholarship or concession is a discretionary privilege given by the Owners of the Academy, subject to high standards of attendance, diligence and behaviour on the student's part and to the Parents treating the School and its staff reasonably. The terms on which such awards are offered and accepted are above. Any value attached to a Scholarship shall be deducted from Fees before any Bursary or other concession is calculated or assessed.

### ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for a PWAcademy scholarship, applicants must meet the following criteria:

1. Be a registered student at PWAcademy; and
2. Demonstrate proficiency and above average commitment and passion for Dance, acting, and singing; and
3. Attend all scheduled classes; and
4. Participate in all PWAcademy performance during our term (September- July);
5. Abide by the specific program rules for the scholarship program; and
6. Abide by PWAcademy's terms and conditions, rules and policies

## SELECTION PROCESS

All students are 'means tested' - All decisions to award scholarships are made by Emma Peploe-Williams, & Stephen M Bunyan, who discuss the scholarship awards and candidates, 3 times a year. Decisions to award scholarships are made at the sole discretion of the Owners of the Academy, based on a child's ability, financial need, and other criteria determined by the Owners. The scholarships are a goodwill gesture by the owners, are funded by them personally, and not a legal right, or a condition of your contract.

## DESCRIPTION OF PWA SCHOLARSHIPS

### FINANCIAL BASED SCHOLARSHIP:

Means Tested Scholarships - Students ages 5 -18 years old are eligible for partial scholarships. PWAcademy is committed to ensuring that every child who wants to dance, act and sing is given the opportunity to perform and we make every effort to give students partial scholarships. If a student is selected for this scholarship they must agree to attend all scheduled classes and participate in all school-term PWAcademy performances. This will come into effect 1st September 2020 for new scholarships awarded to students, but not to existing scholarship students.

### MERIT BASED SCHOLARSHIP:

Students ages 7-18 are eligible for a merit based partial (up to 25% max of fees) scholarship. Students must undergo an audition to be considered for this scholarship. If a student is selected for this scholarship they must agree to attend all scheduled classes and participate in all school-term PWAcademy performances (September - July).

NB. If, as a school, we receive charitable donations from parents, sponsors, philanthropist or charitable donations we will use these for the funding of full scholarships for 'means tested' families only.
